GREEN COUNTRY CHAPTER:

GCC hosted a "Do-Over" Dressage Show on March 11 judged by Roberta Clark. We scheduled rides 15 minutes apart to allow riders to complete their test, discuss it with the judge and re-ride the same test. We found that beginner riders felt a lot more confident the second time through their test. Upper level riders usually chose to only re-do a few elements of the test. Everyone really enjoyed the extra discussion time and the opportunity to retry the test while comments were fresh in their minds. The majority of scores increased on the second test (one was even 9% higher!). We hope to offer this educational opportunity again.

The GCC summer camp will feature Melanie Michalak who uses music as a teaching tool to help riders and their horses maintain a clear and steady rhythm through out their test. Melanie will work with Intro riders through Grand Prix. Those just interested in developing cadence to their ride can benefit as well as those who are interested in working on a freestyle. The camp will be held June 24-25 in Claremore. Stay tuned (no pun intended) for further information!

Anne Kuhns and Marta Koenig from Ok Eventers are working to get a show together on April 23rd at Prairie Lane. This show will have dressage tests and a combined test for the eventers (dressage and stadium jumping). They are finalizing the details and will try get a prizelist out by Thursday at the latest. Sorry this is coming last minute. It should be a good opportunity to give riders from both clubs another competition.

RCC CHAPTER:

RCC will host a massage program is on April 6th at Clydette Womack's. Halie Swan will do a demonstration on equine massage.

RCC will host a pilates clinic on Sat. May 13th at Last November Farm. Patti Barakat, a Pilates instructor who specializes in equine fitness, will work with riders to address body alignment and position of the rider. She will address muscle usage. Pony Clubbers will now be able to achieve the highest rating by virtue of dressage accomplishments. Previously it could only be obtained by jumping accomplishments. To support the Pony Club, NCC will sponsor a year-end Pony Club awards. Details are to be established and will be forthcoming.
