ODS did receive a Region 9 grant for this event.

Also mark your calendar for the **Schooling Show Championships** which will be held on November 15th in the Explorer Arena at the Tulsa Expo. The ODS Board takes seriously your desires and concerns. We have tried to accommodate your learning requests that arose from the survey. We also heard your voices concerning the Schooling Show Championships. This year the Green Country Show will not qualify for Regional's as a rule requires 30 days between the show and the championships. ODS has contracted with judges for next May. Come to the summer meeting and learn who they are. You will be very pleased.

See you at the Summer Meeting. There are many options for attending.

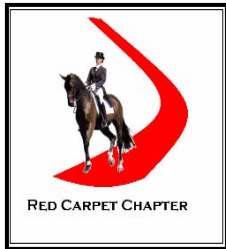
