## **SUMMER GENERAL MEETING (“SGM”) HIGHLIGHTS – JULY 26, 2008**

*AND added comments from your notetaking secretary...*

**ODS Schooling Show Championships** – Date is November 15, 2008; Schooling available Friday, November 14, at Tulsa Expo in the Explorer Arena. This upgraded facility was obtained because membership comments were that participation would increase if we had an indoor ring plus stalls. Having two judges will be dependant upon the number of registered entries.

**ODS Education** – March 28 & 29, 2009 are the dates of our Symposium at the Tulsa Expo in the Explorer Arena. Plans are now being made so we are open to ideas and suggestions. Proposed dates are June 4-7, 2009 for our Adult Camp at the Claremore Expo Center and camp dorm rooms at Rogers State University.

**Great American Insurance Group/USDF Region 9 Dressage Championships and Great Plains Championships Oklahoma Dressage Society Fall Show** – Dates are October 17-19, 2008.

**Fundraising:** We have raised \$7,475 towards our goal! Thank you to those who have fundraised and brought in money: Jolie Pressler for getting SouthPointe Chevrolet to be our Platinum Medal Sponsor, Debbie Nutt for getting FMC Technology to be our Gold Medal Sponsor, and all others who have participated. For those of you who are waiting, we still are looking for funds so please get sponsors, advertisers, vendors, and class sponsors! Our program deadline will be September 15th.

**Planning:** Our Show Secretary, Stacia Wert-Gray, and our Volunteer Coordinator, Bee Pape, have been busy coordinating and planning. Our ODS Board has been organizing and brainstorming.

**Volunteer Positions Needing Volunteers:** Volunteer needs were discussed. Dressage rings and decorations will be set-up October 15 & 16 so all Ring Builders (*yes – its just like Bob the Builder*) and Want-To-Be-Decorators (*tell your husband it will be cheaper than redecorating your kitchen*), we will need you then. Scribes (*those special people who can quietly transcribe, glance up and quickly transcribe some more, and then know when it is appropriate to chit-chat and then when to keep their personal comments to themselves*) who can give their time for full days will be given preference, especially if they are interested in scribing all three days. We will have three rings running daily which will greatly increase the need for Paddock Organizers (*there are requirements for this position: you need to be able to tell time, follow a schedule, and act accordingly; relocate a moving object from one place to another in a helpful manner; and be able to read moving small numbers far away*), and Bit & Whip Checkers (*did you ever want to follow that unsafe driver and contact the authorities because they were not following the rules?*), and, as we have Championship Classes we must have the dressage ring closed after each competitor enters/departs, so we will need Gate People (*no – you don't have to stand at the entrance/exit and keep the horse from coming out of the ring during the test but you do get an excellent view of the test while you sit in the chair*). Because of the numerous rings and numerous tests being ridden (*and competitors who quickly want to know their score before their next class*), we will also need those need-to-walk-even further Runners (*now is the time to buy a new pair of comfortable tennis shoes and make friends with your neighbor's nine year old horse-crazy daughter and her friend*) and Scorers (*begin to start looking for that favorite calculator that you stored in the attic because you now only use your computer*). And don't forget those wonderful volunteers who stay Sunday to help take down the rings, Ring Destroyers, at the end of the show. *A special note to Bee - Christina Harmon has offered to prepare the Judges Baskets.*

**Volunteer Coordinator Positions Already Taken:** We now have a Decoration Committee Coordinator (Roberta Clark), a Merchandise Coordinator (Debbie Nutt), Awards Coordinator (Anne Kuhns), Stable Manager (Darrell Reid), Golf Cart Wrangler (Rainee Boyd), Sponsor/Vendor Coordinators (Rainee Boyd and Jan Cibula), Thursday Evening Cookout Hospitality Coordinator (Debbie Nutt), and Friday Evening Wine & Cheese Party and Saturday Evening Hoe Down Dinner/Dance Coordinator (Jolie Pressler).

**Volunteer Coordinator Positions Needing Volunteers:** We still need a non-competitor to be the Judges/Officials Coordinator (*if you are good at planning carpool schedules; enjoy chauffeuring or waiving goodbye to the chauffer-who starts out in a clean vehicle-with a load of kids to take back & forth to school, baseball, tennis, ballet, and home- without leaving somebody or their belonging behind; and you enjoy coordinating dinner dates; this is your cup of tea*). We are also searching for that special person who likes to get away from it all once in awhile and likes hearing a rhythmic sound, *or is that a cadenced sound*, where they can hear themselves breathe, and have order and balance surrounding them (*no – not get away by going to the spa and*

listening to the soothing waterfall music), this person would be wonderful as our Scoring Coordinator. It appears we also still need a Morning Hospitality Coordinator to get donuts/coffee/juice to Stable Area and Show Office Friday, Saturday, & Sunday mornings (someone preferably who is all smiles early in the morning). If you have a burning desire to coordinate an activity we have not mentioned, let us know... We have fun events planned and you will want to be involved so please contact Stacia or Bee! **“Colic” by Charlotte Kin, DVM** – Our speaker then gave a very informative and detailed presentation on colic (which I had no idea had such an impact in so many places). Number One thing to do when calling the vet: Stay Calm and Don’t Hang Up the Phone until all required information is provided (like providing your name) and, Number Two, if you think your horse is not acting right on Wednesday, don’t wait until Friday at 7:00 p.m. to call the vet; call the vet on Wednesday and let them know what is going on beforehand. Other important information to remember: if your horse develops an eye problem, or a problem at the other end, like diarrhea, or if you feel the desire to give your horse an enema by way of a garden hose; don’t mess around – instead call the vet NOW; all of these situations can be disastrous to your horse.

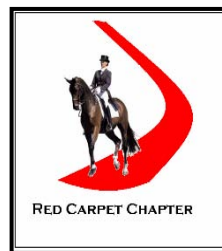

**Details:** Dressage: Intro A through 2nd level; No group classes, no Prix Caprilli tests. Combined tests: GAG through Intermediate.

**Directions: From Tulsa I-44 west.** Exit at #211 (Kellyville/Drumright). Take a left toward route 66, then turn right onto route 66 (toward Kellyville) Go 2 miles. Turn left at signs for Schlumberger and Kellyville rodeo arena onto W. 141<sup>st</sup>. St. South. You will see a black welded fence on the right hand side in approximately one quarter of a mile. Keep driving until you see the mailbox, # 18182. **From Oklahoma City take I-44 east** Exit at # 211 (Kellyville / Drumright). Turn right toward route 66, then right onto route 66 then follow directions above (Go 2 miles...).

**Rules:** USEF rules will be followed to biting, saddlery and use of tie-downs. Riders must wear hard hats and footwear with heels. 2007 USEF tests will be used. 2006 USEA tests “A” for each division. Combined GAG test will use Intro A for dressage. Stallions must be attended at all times. Horses not to be shown must have a negative Coggins presented at the office. A donation to OKE would be appreciated for admittance of horses not to be shown. Juniors, amateurs, and open riders will ride together but be placed separately in dressage only tests. Jr. and Sr. (Am or open) will ride separately and be placed separately in combined tests. Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. Entries must be received by closing date at 5:00 p.m. Late entries may be refused or charged a late fee of \$20 at the discretion of the show management. If cancellations are necessary, a full refund will be made if the show manager is notified before the closing date. All fees must be paid by the closing date unless prior arrangement is made with the show manager. In such case all fees will be due before entering the arena. After closing date, refunds will be made only with a doctor or veterinarian certificate, less \$10.00 office fee. All no-show entries will be billed to the rider. ODS & GCC approved.
