

USDF Trainers Conference January 20 – 21, 2019 Featuring George Williams, Christine Traurig, Charlotte Bredahl, Debbie McDonald

Nancy Burba, Kay Kamish and I traveled to Florida to watch Charlotte Bredahl (US Dressage Developing Coach), Debbie McDonald (US Dressage Technical Advisor), Christina Traurig (US Dressage Young Horse Coach) and George Williams (US Dressage Youth Coach) coach several riders at various levels. This is always an inspiring opportunity to watch top trainers teach as well as see the improvements that can be made in two short days.

Below are some of their comments and observations that we kept hearing during those two days.

--You must have suppleness and relaxation before expression.



- --Control of ribcage is key to suppleness.
- --Do not ask for sensitive before you have sensible.

--Do not train by increasing the number of compensation aids i.e. don't keep making corrections. Rather, make a circle and start again.

- --Any correction or adjustment must lead to being able to execute the movement.
- --The smallest effort must be rewarded, not taken for granted or reason to move on. Teach patiently.
- --The horse can't have more pushing power without more suppleness.
- --Notice if horse shuts down as you shorten rein.
- --Lengthening of the walk and trot isn't just about the stride, but HOW they do it. Must continue to have swing and thrust.
- --Horse with tight back (especially in loin and sacral area) cannot use their legs properly.
- --When the horses loses balance and falls on forehand, go on bending lines DON'T pull.
- --If horse won't go forward, use leg yield with head and neck down make it easier for them to move.

--Really be clear about transitions. Wait for horse to 'understand' before going to next transition.

--Don't be greedy. When you get a good reaction, let them out of the movement.

--Smaller circles should improve tempo, bending and balance or you might as well not bother.

--To improve sitting trot, sit only three strides at a time. Does this interrupt his rhythm? Can you ask him to go forward during the sit? Can you ask him to collect?

--A half halt isn't complete until the rider is able to give.

--Generally half halt only as long as the leg is on the ground, or it's a pull.

--The half halt is not a punishment - should be a request for attention.

--The half halt is a tool to produce horse in the best state of preparedness to work.

--Always set your horse up for success

-- Whip - Is timing correct? Does horse relax when touched with it? Whip should be a friend.

--Use trot-canter transitions to relax the back. Canter-walk transitions have to wait until the back releases since they compress.

--When there is a miscommunication between horse and rider, just continue - no punishment. The horse is allowed to make a mistake.

--Charlotte likes trot-piaffe-trot transitions so horse always thinking about taking the rider forward. Never walks out of piaffe.

--Grand Prix horses don't need 45 minutes of work.

--After all GP movements are achieved and able to be shown, it takes another two years for the horse to mature and reach his potential.

The rides started with a 16-year-old girl who was the Region 1 USDF Dressage Seat Equitation Semi-Finals Champion and went all the way to top-tiered professionals. What was fascinating about each rider was the ability to release their hips in the rhythm of the gaits and give half halts and movement aids without disturbing the rhythm.
