#### GUIDELINES FOR DEMO RIDER SELECTION Beth Baumert ~ The Dynamics of the Interaction Between Horse and Rider April 4-5, 2020

- 1. Any rider may apply however; preference will be given to Oklahoma Dressage Society (ODS) members.
- 2. Horses do not need to be registered with ODS in order to participate. All breeds will be considered.
- 3. Juniors, Amateurs, and Professionals will be considered on an equal basis.
- 4. Riders of all levels are encouraged to apply. Riders must be able to canter and sit the trot. Those riding young horses may rise the trot as appropriate.
- 5. The focus will be with the auditors and maximizing their educational experience.
- 6. Demo riders must be open and willing to learn and to make adjustments as suggested by the clinician.

Riders must also be able to take criticism and not be offended by their riding being discussed in front of an audience.

7. The selection committee will be looking to fill riding slots with a range of levels. The best candidate of each level will be selected. If you are willing to be a demo rider at alternate levels please indicate that on your application.

### **Upcoming Changes For 2020 USDF Breeders Champs Series**

Lexington, KY (October 24, 2019) – The United States Dressage Federation<sup>™</sup> (USDF) announced today upcoming changes to the USDF Breeders Championship Series (USDFBCS), effective January 1, 2020:

- Series have been condensed and reformatted to total nine individual series within the program. Some of the series names have also changed from previous years.
- Horses will no longer be required to attend the series final of the series in which they qualify. While horses may still attend **one** series final competition, it can be the series final competition of choice.
- The qualifying score to compete in an in-hand USDF Breeders Championship Series Final class has been changed to 75%.

USDF Sport Horse Committee Co-Chairs Kristi Wysocki and Natalie DiBerardinis had this to say, "Following a year that saw good growth in many of the USDF Breeders Series Championship Series Finals, and based upon an in-depth evaluation of the overall program, the USDF Sport Horse Committee feels that these changes will further enhance the series, provide flexibility to owners, and give greater opportunities for participation in the finals. We look forward to the 2020 competition season and the continued development of this important program for US breeders."
